2020 ITE Mountain District Award: Student Chapter Award

The ITE Mountain District is committed to recognizing and encouraging student chapters to participate in activities that are in alignment with the purpose and objectives of ITE. The intent of this award is to encourage student chapters to achieve the objectives set forth by their student chapter charters. Additionally, student chapters should strive to show diversity and inclusiveness practices throughout their various activities. Inclusiveness can be described demographically as well as through activities that encourage the engagement of students from additional disciplines of study outside of the traditional transportation curriculum.

Award: The winning student chapter receives a certificate and \$1,000 for travel to the Mountain District Annual Meeting. The District will submit the winning report for consideration in the ITE International competition.

Eligibility

The award will be based on a year extending from March 1 to February 28. Submittals shall follow the evaluation criteria. Where the response is “yes,” please provide a short description of the activity or activities. To qualify for the award, a Student Chapter must submit a narrative that is no longer than five pages with an additional page of photographs:

- Service Projects
- New Member Recruitment;
- Diversity and Inclusion
- Training/Professional Development;
- Field Trips/Technical Tours
